LISTING OF SEVEN (7) ENTITIES

Members of the Public are advised that Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with legislative and international obligations pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 and the United Nations Security Council Resolution (UNSCR) 1373(2001) and successor Resolutions:

High Court Orders have been granted on September 16, 2026 designating the following transnational groups as terrorist entities:

- i. **CV2026-03658 BARRIO 18 also known as CALLE 18 also known as THE REVOLUTIONARIES also known as SUREÑOS**
- ii. **CV2026-03660 - CARTEL DE LOS SOLES also known as CARTEL OF THE SUNS**
- iii. **CV2026-03655- PRIMEIRO COMANDO DA CAPITAL also known as PCC also known as FIRST CAPITAL COMMAND**
- iv. **CV2026-03657 - SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as NEW MARQUETALIA also known as SECOND MARQUETALIA also known as LA NUEVA MARQUETALIA also known as FARC DISSIDENTS SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as REVOLUTIONARY ARMED FORCES OF COLOMBIA DISSIDENTS SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as FARC-D SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as GRUPO ARMADO ORGANIZADO RESIDUAL SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as GAO-R SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as RESIDUAL ORGANIZED ARMED GROUP SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA also known as ARMED ORGANIZED RESIDUAL GROUP SEGUNDA MARQUETALIA**
- v. **CV2026- 03659 -COMANDO VERMELHO also known as RED COMMAND**
- vi. **CV2026-03617-REVOLUTIONARY ARMED FORCES OF COLOMBIA—PEOPLE'S ARMY also known as FARC-EP**
- vii. **CV2026-03615 - LOS LOBOS also known as THE LOBOS also known as LOS LOBOS DRUG TRAFFICKING ORGANIZATION**

The effect of the Orders granted are as follows:

- i. The entities named therein are listed entities pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and

- ii. The property owned or controlled, directly or indirectly and derived or generated from funds or other assets owned or controlled, directly or indirectly by the Defendants are frozen.

Members of the Public are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property or support to any “listed entity” is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap 12:07.
